KUT's Special Scholarship Program is a 3-year English-medium doctoral program designed for highly capable doctoral students. Successful applicants are entitled to receive following benefits:

- 1. Exempted from all the required student fees
- 2. 150,000 yen per month for research project work
- 3. 150,000 yen for travel and initial living cost (given only to international applicants who are living outside Japan)
